- ◇ GED graduates are more likely to be employed full time than high school dropouts.
- ◇ About half of GED graduates attended two or four-year colleges after earning their GED credentials.
- ◇ Passing the GED represents a level of literacy widely viewed as necessary for social and economic advancement.
