Flanagan-Cornell High School provides a four-year preparatory curriculum with over 75 course offerings in a traditional schedule. Students have access to honors level courses and dual credit classes through Illinois Central College, Heartland Community College, and through enrollment in the Livingston Area Career Center (LACC).
