PTHS provides a four-year college preparatory curriculum with over 100 course offerings. PTHS students have access to honors level courses and eight dual credit courses through Heartland Community College in addition to nine Advanced Placement courses.

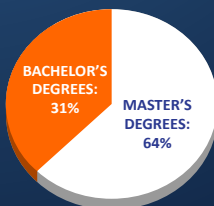
A variety of social- emotional supports, including mental health counselling, are also available.
